Red Deer Nordic submitted a calendar of events and Parkland executive approved it by an e-mail vote. Vance moved the motion and Brian seconded it. No discussion. Everyone was in favor. The calendar of events was then submitted to Cross Country Alberta. Discussion on any future tours or events need to be added to the calendar and then voted on through e-mails.

Linda moved that the Day Tours on Friday, Jan. 6th and 14th at Spruce View will be added to the calendar. Dick will add it to the calendar. Vance seconded it. No discussion. Everyone was in favor.

OLD BUSINESS

Brian moved: That the CRS (Companion Rescue Skills) or above training is mandatory for all skiers participating on intermediate or above tours. This requirement would be fulfilled if you have ASTI or companion rescue. Leaders will have to have the AST-1 (Avalanche Safety Training level 1) or above to lead those tours. These changes will be implemented by December 1, 2013.

corollary: We plan to have in house CRS instructors trained in that time period as well to save money and allow for better planning. Motion passed via e-mail vote (7 votes in favor and three no responses).

Brian discussed the idea of classifying our rating system as posted in Parks Canada as being a challenging tour/expert tour rather than a strong beginner/intermediate tour. The tours should be based on the terrain evaluation rather than the physical evaluation. Brian will rate some tours before the next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS

Discussion on increasing membership fees because the ski insurance is \$500 more this year. Dick mentioned that the club would be in the red if we didn't have the income of the ski lessons. Dick will prepare an expense form supporting this idea for the next meeting.
